REORGANIZATION MEETING CALL TO ORDER

Senator Cruz-Perez administered the Oath of Office to Commissioner Michael "Traz" Tovinsky, Commissioner Andrew J. Gilmore and Commissioner Joseph E. Wolk individually. Each were accompanied by their family members. The commissioners then returned to the dais.
