

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-10

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 354 OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT EPHRAIM,
COUNTY OF CAMDEN, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ENTITLED "SOLID WASTE", IN
THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT EPHRAIM**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Borough of Mount Ephraim, County of Camden, and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 354 entitled "Solid Waste" in the Code of the Borough is Mount Ephraim hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 1.

**ARTICLE II
Disposal Regulations**

§ 354-16 **Debris removal.**

- A.** Debris generated by a contractor shall be entirely disposed of by said contractor.
- B.** Debris generated solely by a resident on his own property shall be subject to the following:
 - (1)** Small debris shall be placed in containers not exceeding 40 pounds adequate to hold such weight of contents when lifted.
 - (2)** All other debris shall be tied in bundles not exceeding 40 pounds in weight and
 - (3)** Debris to be removed shall be placed at the curb in such a manner so as not to obstruct driveways or public walks.
 - (4)** Debris shall be limited to one cubic yard per week.

SECTION 2: Except as set forth in Sections 1 above, the balance of Chapter 354 shall not be affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 5: If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
